N.C. Driving Eligibility Certificate

Driving Eligibility Certificates are available in Student Services. This form must be signed by a parent/guardian and returned with your Driver Education Certificate plus a report card with the latest semester final grades to Student Services. DEC's are signed/sealed once a week and are ready every Wednesdays during your lunch for pick up. Remember the DEC's are only good for 30 days after they are signed/sealed.
