Guidelines for Success - It takes **PREPARATION – RESPONSIBILITY – INTEGRITY – DEDICATION and EFFORT** to be successful.

GRADING - Your final grade will reflect what you have learned, not what you have completed!

- Quarter grades will be calculated from formative assignments ((50%- labs, class work, notebook, quizzes, homework) and summative assignments (50% - tests, projects, mid-term exam)
- Grades posted regularly on **SPAN**, accessible by you and your parent/guardian
- Grade disbursement - A= 93-100 B=85-92 C=77-84 D=70-76 F= < 70
- Grade reports – interims are distributed every three weeks, report cards every nine weeks

ABSENCES

- Students may not check out without your permission, and MUST check out through the attendance office

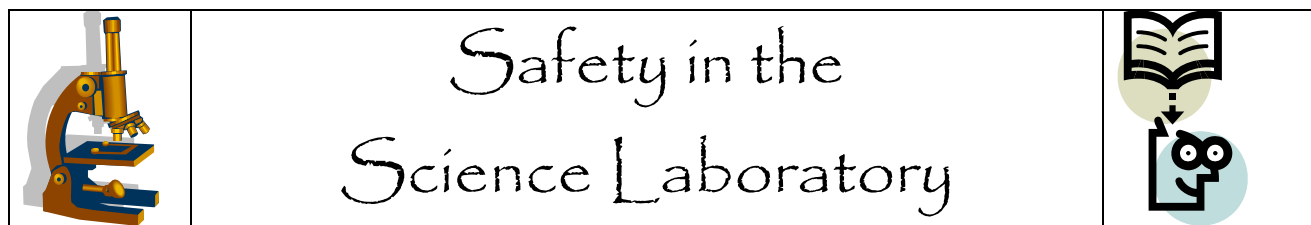

STEP ONE	Student scores more than one "D" or "F" on Quiz or Test	Conference with Student – discuss strategies, habits, review test/quiz results
STEP TWO	Low performance continues	Parent/Guardian contacted – discuss strategies
STEP THREE	Low performance continues	Mandatory Tutoring – with parent contact and contract
STEP FOUR	Low performance continues	Teacher—parent—student Conference is scheduled.
STEP FIVE	Low performance continues	Referral to MHS Intervention Plan



In order to decrease the chances of any accident occurring in the science lab, all students and visitors must follow the safety rules and procedures listed below.

1. Horseplay, running, pushing and practical jokes are not permitted.
2. Never EAT or DRINK in the laboratory.
3. All work surfaces must be cleaned after each use and prior to leaving the lab. Keep your desk and floor area clean at all times.
4. Broken and chipped glass should never be used.
5. Never try to pick up broken glass. The teacher should clean it up.
6. Always wash your hands after lab exercises. Never put your fingers, pencils, pens, or any equipment used in the lab into your mouth.
7. Note the locations of the following: fire extinguisher, eye wash/ shower, and fire blanket
8. Report all injuries to the teacher immediately! Don't be afraid to tell the teacher of an accident.
9. Follow your teacher's directions at all times.
10. Do not handle equipment unless you have permission to do so.
11. Preparation prevents accidents and improves performance – READ your lab directions TWICE before beginning any activity.
